Age	Procedure / Vaccination

**Teeth:** Some puppies, especially smaller breeds, will not lose their baby teeth when their adult teeth come in. These extra teeth, commonly referred to as retained deciduous teeth, can cause numerous problems for your pet. We therefore routinely pull any baby teeth present at the time of the spay/neuter.

**Future Vaccinations:** The Bordatella vaccine should be boosted every 6 months and will be due again around 9 months of age. DHPP and Rabies vaccines are boosted again after one year and will be due again around 16 months of age.

**Post Vaccination:** It is not uncommon for a puppy to be a little sore or sleepy a few days after receiving vaccines. Please let us know if your puppy has any signs lasting longer than a couple days.

**Flea Control:** Monthly flea and heartworm preventative medications are based on your puppy's weight. As your puppy grows and matures we will need to adjust the size of the medications we send home with you. Please mark your pet's flea control and heartworm preventative schedule on your calander and call us monthly with your puppy's up to date weight so that we can accurately perscribe the necessary medication.
